A course entitled " Sensitive Compartmented Information Facility; Planning, Design, and Construction (SCIF-PDC)" will be offered 5-8 December 2017 at Humphreys Engineer Center in Springfield, Virginia. It is presented by the Corps of Engineers Protective Design Mandatory Center of Expertise. The cost of the course is \$1,200, which includes current criteria and electronic reference materials. Classes will start at 8:00 a.m. and conclude at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day. Student travel and per diem costs are not included.

The SCIF-PDC course is intended for an interdisciplinary group; including project managers, engineers, designers, and architects. This course is intended for all applicable parties who are involved in new or retrofit SCIF projects. Installation level, command level, and Corps of Engineers personnel are encouraged to attend. Representatives from other federal government agencies may also attend.

Once payment is received, a confirmation letter, including directions, a partial list of area hotels will be sent to the student. <u>Payment deadline is 2 November 2017.</u>
