## **DATA REQUIRED BY THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974**

### **AUTHORITY**

The Rivers and Harbors Act of 1894 as amended and supplemented (33 U.S.C. 1)

### **PRINCIPAL PURPOSE**

Provide the Corps of Engineers with information for contact of the responsible person applying for and/or receiving a Shoreline Management (Duck Blind) permit. The description of the activity is needed to assure conditions of the permit requirements are met.

### **ROUTINE USES**
