ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SUPPORTING NJD (e.g., paragraph 1 – site conditions; paragraphs 2-3 – rationale used to determine NJD, including information reviewed to assess potential navigation or interstate commerce connections; and paragraph 4 – site information on waters of the U.S. occurring onsite): The proposed 160 acre development site consists of an isolated/nonjurisdictional wetland, two linear wetlands, a manmade wetland/pond resulting from an active mine operation and a manmade diversion channel around the gravel mine. The isolated wetland is primarily outside the project boundaries, with less than 0.5 acres on the project and is to not be disturbed. The two linear wetlands are contiguous to the manmade diversion ditch/tributary. The manmade diversion ditch has a bed and bank and is a tributary to the Big Sioux river. The NWI, USGS Quad. maps, aerial photos, consultants reports and site visit were utilized for the jurisdictional determination. The isolated wetland has no surface water connection to waters of the US and no valid ICC.
