Requires construction of 1.393 acres of scrub-shrub wetlands and restoration of 0.81 acre of wetlands temporarily impacted to mitigate project impacts. impact 1.45 acres of scrub-shrub wetlands and 0.65 acre of riverine habitats. Requires restoration of 1.07 acres of wetlands by implementing the Turbid Lake Road obliteration project to mitigate for permanent project impacts and restoration of the 1.45 acres of scrub-shrub wetlands and 0.65 acre of riverine habitat temporarily impacted by construction activities. Located along the East Entrance Road Corridor in Yellowstone National Park from the East Entrance Gate to Sylvan Pass located in Township 52 North, Range 110 West, Park County.

Upgrade and rehabilitation of a portion of Lane 9 road located west of Powell, Wyoming. Authorized work includes the permanent placement of dredged and fill material into .085 acre of emergent wetlands and 0.34 acre of open water. The project involves the placement of approximately 2,600 feet of Bitter Creek into a 60-inch pipe. Requires implementation of the Newell Springs Creek wetland and waters restoration plan to mitigate for project impacts. The mitigation plan is to be designed to result in the restoration/and or enhancement of 1.75 acres of emergent wetland and approximately 7000 lineal feet of stream channel. Located in Sections 8 and 9, Township 55 North, Range 99 West, Park County.

Upgrade and reconstruction of a portion of U.S. Highway 150, from the Utah Border north for approximately 10 miles. Authorized work includes the permanent placement of fill material into 4.758 acres of emergent and scrub-shrub wetlands and temporary impacts to 4.04 acres of wetlands. To mitigate

for authorized project impacts of the current project and failed mitigation from a previous related project, requires creation of 6.356 acres of emergent and scrub-shrub wetlands part of which is at an offsite location but within the same Bear River watershed. Also requires the restoration of the 4.04 acres of wetlands temporarily impacted by the project. Located in Sections 9, 16, 21, 28, 32 and 33, Township 13 North and Sections 5, 6, 7, 18 and 20 of Township 12 North, all in Range 119 West, Uinta County.

Applicant proposed the construction of 2 reservoirs on the South Fork of Crazy Woman Creek to store 519 acre-feet of water for the purpose of providing supplemental irrigation to existing currently irrigated lands. Total proposed project impacts were 6.354 acres of wetlands and stream channels. The applicant was notified in a letter dated November 20, 2003, from the Corps that the application was being withdrawn because it did not contain sufficient information to meet Corps regulatory requirements needed to render a determination. The applicant was advised of the application deficiencies. Located in Sections 8 and 9, Township 47 North, Range 81 West, Johnson County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office authorized 14 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. The office also verified 45 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the issued permits listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
