Construction of a livestock barrier and associated bank stabilization. Authorized work includes the construction of a rock weir about 116 feet across the river and a rock revetment that will extend along the river bank 25 feet upstream from the weir and 130 feet downstream from the weir. Located in and along the Green River in the SW ¼, Section 15, Township 33 North, Range 110 West, Sublette County.

200140116	City of Green River	<b>Issued</b>	2/19/02
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Construction of the Green River Whitewater Improvement Project to improve recreational whitewater boating. Authorized work includes the construction of 3 new drop structures and modification of an existing-low head dam to serve as a fourth drop structure. Other authorized project features include 4 double current deflectors, the random placement of 20 boulders, and 800 feet of bank protection. The use of temporary cofferdams during the construction period is also authorized. Located in and along the Green River near Expedition Island in the City of Green River, in Section 22, Township 18 North, Range 107 West, Sweetwater County.

200140003	Wyoming Department of Transportation	<b>Issued</b>	2/20/02
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Discharge of dredge and fill material in conjunction with the rehabilitation and upgrade of the US Highway 789, covering about 9 miles of the highway between Lander and Hudson, Wyoming. Authorized work includes the permanent discharge of fill material into 4.3 acres of emergent and scrub-shrub wetlands and temporary impacts to about 0.2 acre of emergent wetland. Construction of 4.3 acres of emergent wetlands is required to mitigate for permanent wetland impacts. Restoration of 0.2 acre of emergent wetland temporarily impacted is also required. Construction of up to 10 bendway weirs in the Popo Agie River at project stations 205+00 to 210+00 is also authorized. Located in and along the Popo Agie River and adjacent tributaries and wetlands in various sections, Townships 33 and 34 North, Ranges 98 and 99 West, Fremont County.

Construction of an upstream vortex weir checkdam to allow for a reliable water supply to the Jim Bridger Power Plant intake. Permanent large stone structure will replace temporary earthen structures that have been historically authorized, constructed and modified at this location. The use of temporary cofferdams is also authorized as part of this project. Located in the Green River in the City of Green River, in the SW ¼, Section 15, Township 18 North, Range 107 West, Sweetwater County.

200140100	Shoshone National Forest	Issued	3/15/02
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Discharge of dredge and fill material in conjunction with the Tie Hack Bank Stabilization Project to be undertaken by the Washakie Ranger District of Shoshone National Forest. This project was originally proposed for authorization under Nationwide Permit 27. However, the Corps took discretionary authority and required review under individual permit procedures due to the extensive work proposed and potential for adverse impacts. Authorized work includes the construction of 7 cross vanes, 25 rock vanes and 2 j-hooks. Excavation and redistribution of 3,124 cubic yards of channel sediments for construction, modification of width: depth ratio and riffle-pool work is also authorized. Excavated materials will be redistributed to build riffle bars, point bars, sill structures and flood plains. About 0.23 acres of wetland will be impacted but is expected to be re-established as part of this channel rehabilitation project. Located on the Wind River in Sections 33 and 34, Township 43 North, Range 109 West, Fremont County.

200040261	Teton County Road and Levee Department	Issued	3/25/02
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After-the-fact authorization to discharge dredge and fill material excavated from the Snake River into about .07 acre of Taylor Creek and its associated wetlands. Gravel material discharged was used in the rehabilitation of the Wilson-Fall Creek road and for the construction of a temporary detour while work was in progress on the Wilson-Fall Creek road culvert crossing. The detour has been removed and Taylor Creek and wetlands restored to pre-existing conditions. Taylor Creek work was located in the SW ¼, and Snake River excavation work located in the SE ¼, both in Section 14, Township 40 North, Range 117 West, Teton County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office authorized 15 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. The office also verified 29 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range, and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the issued permits listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
