200240284	Wyoming Dept. of Transportation Upgrade and rehabilitation of the Buffalo West Section of U.S. Highway 16. Authorized work includes the placement of dredge and fill material into 0.77 acre of emergent, scrub-shrub and forested wetlands and impacts to approximately 3,000 linear feet of Mosier Gulch. Requires creation of 1.07 acres of scrub-shrub wetlands and restoration of 0.38 acres of wetlands to mitigate project impacts. Located in	Issued	3/26/03

Sections 4, 5, 7, and 8, Township 50 North, Range 83 West, and Sections 11 and 12, Township 50 North, Range 84 West, Johnson County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office authorized 4 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. This office also verified 45 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the issued permits listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
