Bear River Channel Improvements for the purpose of improving whitewater boating characteristics in the Bear River in the City of Evanston. Construction of 6-U-Drop Structures, 2 double current deflectors, 8 single current deflectors, stone terrace along 1,520 feet of bank, and 30 random boulder placements. Authorized work includes the permanent placement of about 5,251 cubic yards of rock into about 0.6 acres of river channel to construct the structures. River channel excavation is also authorized and will generate about 3,805 cubic yards of gravel to be used in site preparation, to create pools, and construct temporary cofferdams. Total area of channel disturbance due to excavation is limited to 1.5 acres. Located in Sections 21 and 22, Township 15 North, Range 120 West, Uinta County.

Jackson Hole Mountain Resort Facility Improvements. Authorized activities include replacement and relocation of the Eagle's Rest Lift; relocation of the lower terminal of the Teewinot Lift; grading of the base area around both lifts; construction of the Eagle's Rest Cut-Off Trail; and improvements of the Antelope Flats, Werner, and Teewinot Trails. Grading of the base area will affect 0.31 acre of wetland and includes placement of fill material into portions of Crystal Springs and Solitude Creeks. Mitigation for project impacts includes restoration of .24 acre of palustrine emergent wetland (PEM) and creation of 0.21 acre of PEM and creation of 0.06 acre of palustrine forested (PFO) wetland in the base area. Another 0.15 acre of PEM wetland and 0.39 acre of PFO wetland is to be created off-site adjacent to a small unnamed stream channel near the Apres Vous Ski Lift. Located at the Jackson Hole Mountain Resort in Section 24, Township 42 North, Range 117 West, Teton County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office authorized 4 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. The office also verified 57 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the issued permits listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
