Issued 6/20/00

Established General Permit (GP) 98-08, for the discharge of fill material associated with oil and gas exploration and development on both public and private lands in the State of Wyoming. May be used to authorize surveys, roads, utilities, reservoirs, erosion control, and hazardous waste cleanup activities associated with oil and gas exploration and development. Issued in accordance with the provisions of "33 CFR Parts 320 through 330, Regulatory Programs of the Corps; Final Rule," as published in the Federal Register, Volume 51, No. 219, dated Thursday, November 13, 1986, Part 325.5(c). Applicable to all waters of the U.S., including wetlands, in Wyoming, except as noted. Applicable to all counties in Wyoming. Requires verification of authorization from the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) or the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) for all projects located on federal land or land with federal minerals. Requires submittal of a "Pre-construction Notification" (PCN) to the Corps in accordance with the application procedures set forth in the GP for activities located on non-federal land with non-federal minerals.

Wetland fills (1.11 acres) at 14 locations associated with the construction of the Laramie River Bike Path from Optimist Park to Curtis Street, a distance of 1.64 miles, in Laramie, adjacent to the Laramie River, Albany Co.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office also authorized 5 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. The office also verified 275 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range, and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the permit actions listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
