Installation of four 48-inch culverts with headgates in an existing levee that involves fill in the Snake River and two high flow channels. Also, fish habitat enhancement in Price Spring Creek and associated tributaries. Work includes removal of approximately 150 cubic yards of fill and associated riprap and the subsequent discharge of a single 48-inch CMP measuring about 50 feet long and 250 cubic yards of rock as well as 150 cubic yards of riprap in one high flow channel. Also, the removal of approximately 700 cubic yards of fill and riprap and subsequent discharge of three 48-inch CMP culverts measuring 60 feet in length each and 650 cubic yards of gravel and 150 cubic yards of rock riprap in another high flow channel. Discharge of 20 cubic yards of concrete in conjunction with installation of the headgates and 225 cubic yards of large rock to create a levee hard point is also authorized. Fish habitat work in side channels of the Snake River include:

- Excavation of 400 cubic yards of channel sediments at 8 sites.
- Excavation of 2800 cubic yards from 2 sites to create pools.
- Discharge of 1200 cubic yards of spawning gravel at 12 sites.
- Discharge of large woody debris at 3 locations.
- Discharge of 200 cubic yards of fill to fill two channel depressions.
- Excavation of approximately 100 cubic yards of fine silt from 6 locations.

Located on the Snake River and its high flow channels and Price Spring Creek in Teton County.

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Discharge of dredge and fill material in conjunction with the construction of a golf course and residential subdivision. Authorized work includes the discharge of fill material into 0.94 acres of emergent wetlands at 8 locations for golf holes, a driving range, and several road crossings. Also, the relocation of 900 feet of an ephemeral channel known as Denio Draw. The

discharge of 496 cubic yards of riprap for bank stabilization and fisheries habitat improvement, installation of three utility lines, and an access road/bridge in Little Goose Creek are also part of the authorized project. The applicant is required to create 2.09 acres of emergent wetlands and open water to mitigate for the 0.94 acres of emergent wetlands impacted. Located on Little Goose Creek and adjacent tributaries and wetlands in Sheridan County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office also authorized 3 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. This office also verified 358 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range, and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the permit actions listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
