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Proposed after-the-fact authorization of a completed access road constructed in wetlands. Involved the discharge of river cobble and clean fill into 0.185 acres of wetlands adjacent to the Middle Popo Agie River. Road constructed was 270 lineal feet across and approximately 30 feet wide. Applicant voluntarily restored wetlands by filling in a ditch constructed in conjunction with the road construction. They reduced project impacts to .09 acres allowing the work to fit the requirements of a nationwide permit. The site was inspected by Corps personnel and restoration work confirmed. Remaining fills were verified as authorized by nationwide permit. Wetlands adjacent to Middle Fork Popo Agie River - Fremont County.

200140046	Half Moon Lake Lodge	Issued	9/9/01
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Construction of a jetty in Half Moon Lake. The jetty will be 123 feet long at the crest with a top width of 6 feet. It will have a maximum height of 23 feet above the lakebed and 2.5 feet above the water surface. The area filled by the base of the jetty in the lake will be about 0.14 acre. About 1,950 cubic yards of rock fill will be used in its construction. Half Moon Lake - Sublette County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office also authorized 17 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. This office also verified 160 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide

permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range, and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the permit actions listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
