Purpose of the project is to provide whitewater recreational opportunities on the North Platte River. Authorized work includes the discharge of approximately 5,600 cubic yards of rock to construct 3 V-Dams, 35 randomly placed boulders, 4,000 cubic yards of rock to construct 3 double current deflectors, and 780 cubic yards of rock to stabilize 1,100 feet of riverbank. Located in the North Platte River near the City of Casper in Section 8, Township 33 North, Range 79 West, Natrona County.	Issued	8/2/02

Demolition and removal of the "Old Yellowstone Highway Bridge" over the North Platte River in Casper. Authorized work includes the discharge of approximately 900 cubic yards of coarse granular material and concrete barriers for temporary access roads to facilitate removal, the temporary discharge of approximately 2,450 cubic yards of concrete and steel rubble from the bridge demolition, and the discharge of 20 cubic yards of clean gravel over a 600 foot square area for fish spawning purposes. About 0.37 acre of river channel and adjacent wetlands will be temporarily filled due to authorized activities. All authorized temporary fills are to be completely removed upon project completion. Located in the North Platte River in the City of Casper in the NE ¼, Section 7, Township 33 North, Range 79 West, Natrona County.

Construction of a rock structure over the Town of Pinedale water transmission line in Fremont Lake. Purpose of the structure is to protect the Town's water transmission line from damage due to ice formation. Authorized work includes the placement of approximately 1,650 cubic yards of rock to create a rock structure over the

pipeline with a base width of 40 feet, a height of 6.7 feet with 3:1 side slopes, and a length of 320 feet. The structure will fill 0.29 acre of the lakebed. Located near the Town of Pinedale in Fremont Lake in the NW ¼, Section 23, Township 34 North, Range 109 West, Sublette County.

During the period covered by this public notice, the Wyoming Regulatory Field Office authorized 11 projects under the provisions of the regional general permits available for use in Wyoming. The office also verified 134 projects to be done in accordance with the Corps nationwide permits applicable and available for use in Wyoming.

Anyone interested in knowing if an activity observed in a waterway or wetland in Wyoming has been authorized by an individual, regional, or nationwide permit is encouraged to contact the Wyoming Regulatory Office. Responses to such inquiries will be facilitated if the individual inquiring is able to provide the location of the activity by quarter, section, township, range and county or the name of the individual or organization responsible for the work.

An Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement, if such was required, and a Statement of Findings and/or Record of Decision were prepared on each of the issued permits listed above and are on file in the Omaha District, Corps of Engineers, Wyoming Regulatory Office, 2232 Dell Range Blvd., Suite 210, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82009.
